

ACM Secures Remote Workers With Netskope

Netskope worked closely with ACM to ensure that NG-SWG satisfied all of their web security and policy control needs, and with ACM and Google to ensure that the NPA plug-in was fully compatible with Chrome OS.

The challenge

Australian Community Media (ACM) needed to enable secure remote access for their highly mobile workforce who use Chromebooks, along with visibility and control of traffic flowing between Chromebooks and the public internet. They also needed flexible smart policy controls that allow filtering across job functions so, for example, their journalists could easily be granted access to certain content.

The solution

ACM replaced their traditional VPN with Netskope Private Access (NPA) for secure, zero trust access to corporate apps from Chromebooks, and Netskope next-gen secure web gateway (NG-SWG) for secure web access with the ability to discover and block exfiltration of sensitive data in real-time. Netskope developed and deployed a plug-in for ACM to support Chrome OS.

The result

NPA provides secure zero trust network access to enterprise and public cloud applications for ACM's employees regardless of location. A top benefit for ACM is complete control and visibility of remote users. With NG-SWG, ACM can flexibly control access to sites and information as required by employees. Finally, ACM benefits from reduced help tickets due to strong support provided by Netskope.

NPA also helps reduce our threat surface, which is a significant security boost. Rather than access the full network, our remote users can now only access the applications they need.”

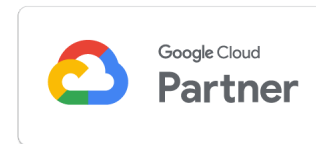
