

Boston Partners migrates from Google to Google for Nonprofits

Boston Partners planned to relocate their headquarters at the beginning of 2020. 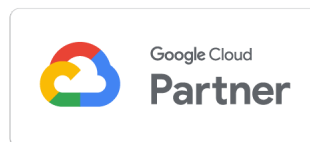
